

Livingston County Republican Party – <u>Official Convention Rules</u> for the February 15, 2024, Livingston County Republican Convention.

- 1. The Livingston County Republican Party (LCRP) County Convention will be held per the rules governed by the Michigan Republican Party (MRP).
- 2. Per MRP rules, only duly elected Precinct Delegates and those designated "Delegates-at-Large" shall be allowed to vote in matters presented at the February 15, 2024, LCRP County Convention. "Delegates-at-Large" consist of our state legislators and statewide officeholders, those elected to county-wide office, our most recent Republican nominee for state legislature or county officer, and any MRP party officers residing in our county.
- 3. Per MRP Rules, there shall be no proxy voting. Delegates must be physically present to vote, and all voting must take place inside the convention room.
- 4. A secret ballot method shall be used for voting. The proposed manner of voting for 61 Delegates and 61 Alternates to the March 2, 2024 Congressional District Convention has been approved by the LCRP Executive Committee during a previous Executive Committee meeting. The voting method that was approved is Association Voting online, <u>https://vote.associationvoting.com/lcgop/</u> Ballot(s) will not be available until voting opens.
- 5. The first round of voting shall be to select 61 Delegates to participate In the Congressional District Convention on March 2, 2024 to be held at the Huntington Center in the City of Detroit. Each eligible Delegate may vote for up to 61 persons on the ballot. If there is a tie for the 61st spot, a draw of numbers shall decide who receives the last delegate position.
- 6. The second round of voting shall be to select the 61 Alternates to the Congressional District Convention. The ballot for Alternates shall consist of those who were on the first ballot but were not among the 61 Delegates voted to participate in the March 2nd Congressional District Convention in round one. Each eligible Delegate may vote for up to 61 persons on the second round ballot. Ties in votes shall be broken by a draw of numbers or by mutual consent.
- 7. The LCRP will close the ballot on Sunday, February 11th by 8pm. The official ballot will be published on our website by noon on Monday, February 12, 2024.
- 8. County Convention check-in will begin at 6pm on Thursday, February 15, 2024. **You must show photo ID to receive credentials and be eligible to vote.** Convention begins at 7pm.
